3 The Parliament of Australia enacts:

4 **1 Short title**

5 This Act is the *Export Control Legislation Amendment*
6 (*Certification of Narcotic Exports*) Act 2020.

7 **2 Commencement**

8 (1) Each provision of this Act specified in column 1 of the table
9 commences, or is taken to have commenced, in accordance with
10 column 2 of the table. Any other statement in column 2 has effect

Schedule 1—Amendments

Export Control Act 1982

1 Section 3 (definition of goods)

Repeal the definition, substitute:

goods means:

- (a) an animal or a plant, or part of an animal or a plant; or
- (b) an article or a substance (including reproductive material) derived from an animal or a plant, whether or not in combination with any other article or substance; or
- (c) food.

Export Control Act 2020

2 Section 12 (paragraph (d) of the definition of goods)

Omit “;”, substitute “.”.

3 Section 12 (definition of goods)

Omit “but does not include narcotic goods within the meaning of the *Customs Act 1901*.”.
