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Bankruptcy and Cannabis

A common remedy not available to cannabis operators.

- Bankruptcy Chapter 11 and Chapter 7
- Marijuana still federally illegal
- Operators forced to rely on state and common-law protections







What is the alternative for cannabis operators?



- Arbitration and dispute resolution
- Asset sales

- Hiring managed service operators
- Receiverships





What is a Receivership?



- A protective judicial umbrella
- A powerful tool to secure assets

 A court-controlled, 3rd party custodian of an entity's property, finances, and other general assets



Why rely on a Receivership?

- Protects creditors and/or assets
- Restructure companies
- Company heading towards bankruptcy or financial distress
- Improve operations





Why a Receivership for Cannabis?

 Bankruptcy courts throw out medical and adult-use cannabis cases

A turn-around tool

Allows for objectivity and transparency





How is a Receivership Triggered?

- Financial Distress
- Distressed Assets
- Fraud
- Regulatory Issues
- Failing Operations
- Initiated via a court action from an affected party

 Only a handful of states have enacted statutory protections




Conflicting Interests in a Receivership
